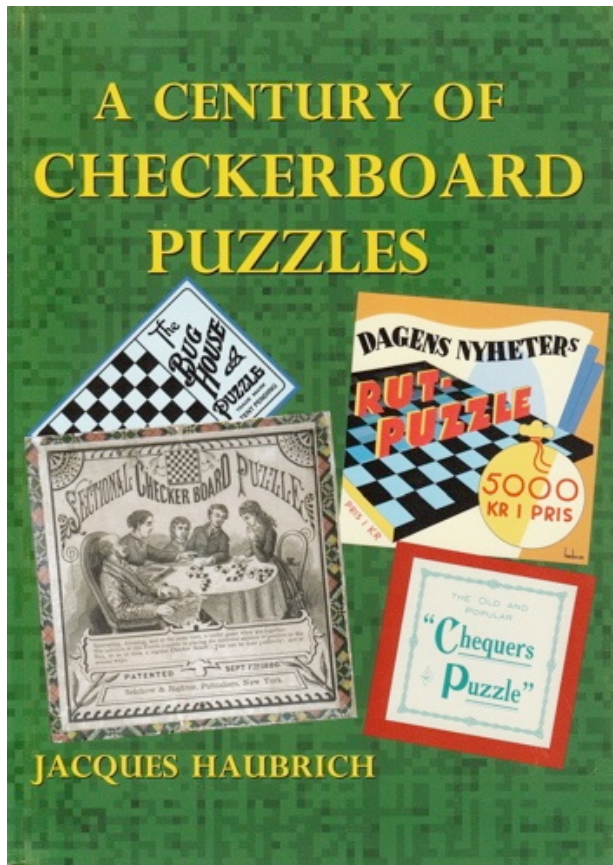

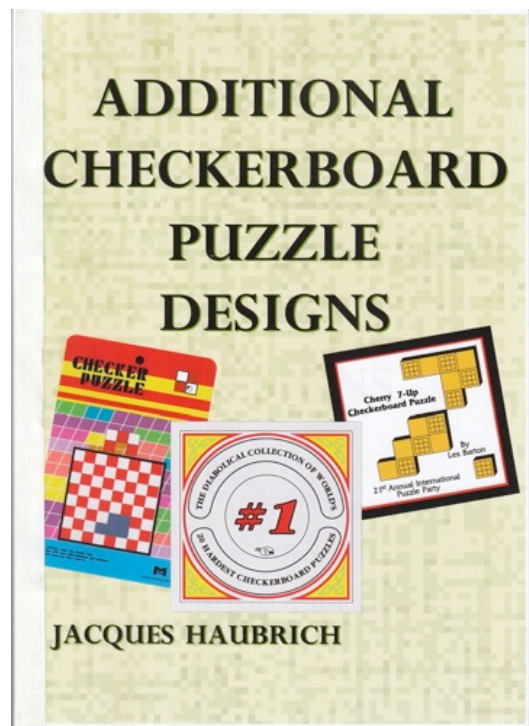

A checkerboard, 8x8 squares large, dissected along the lines into a number of pieces.

The puzzle is then to assemble the pieces to form that original checkerboard again. Typically 10 to 12 pieces, often with many solutions, and never as easy as it looks.

This book describes all known checkerboard puzzles and their solutions that are based on designs from the beginning around 1880 until a century later around 1980.
