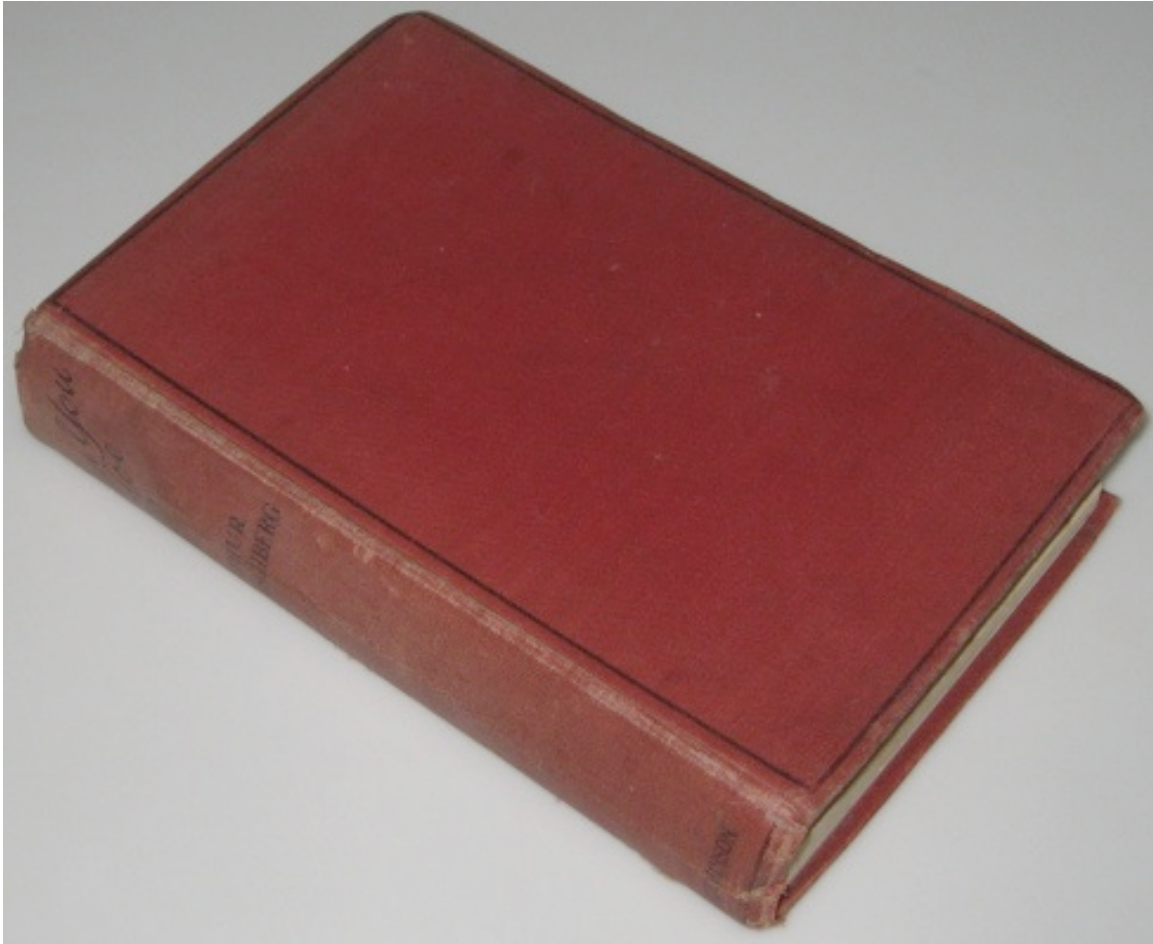


The 1930 Hirschberg Book
