## Atomic Chaos


a.k.a. Kaos

The top and bottom halves of these tubes can be rotated with respect to each other, and the balls can be shifted back and forth. Jaap's Page gives a solution. This puzzle was made in a number of versions that are the same except for the color of the balls and the packaging.


BRAIN DRAIN is a puzzle that calls for manipulation and logical thinking. It is made up of two symmetrical halves, one below the other, which also turn around a central axle and allow a simple sequence of movements. The puzzle can be turned up side down to allow the balls to fall, and it can be twisted to sort them into tubes. The aim is to sort them into separate colours in each tube (see diagram (1)). Or to fill each tube with balls of different colours (see diagram (2)).

BRAIN DRAIN, the puzzle that will make you lose your marbles !
