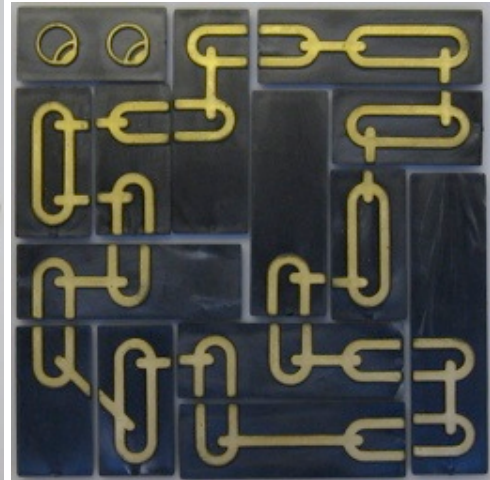


Krazee Links

This puzzle consists of 14 blocks, 13 of which have imprinted on their surface sections of the KRAZEE LINKS CHAIN. If the blocks are properly placed in the platform of the plastic case, it is possible to link the sections together to form a continuous—Endless CHAIN.
