a.k.a. Spots Puzzle

St. Pierre \& Patterson Mfg. Co. 1957.
(cardboard tray and nine $2 \times 5 / 8$ inch square red wood bars with recessed white dots; shown as the "Spots Puzzle" on pages 98-99, 130-131 of the 1893 Hoffmann book)
Assemble nine $1 \times 1 \times 3$ unit bars into a die; from left to right in the photo above, the dots are:

| 1. no dots | 6. top left \& right |
| :--- | :--- |
| 2. left end | 7. top left \& right, end left \& right |
| 3. top center | 8. top left \& right, end left \& right, front right |
| 4. top center | 9. top left \& right, end left, front left \& right |
| 5. top left, end right |  |
