
a.k.a. Crazy Tetrahedron Plus

Purchased from Mefferts, 2011. (plastic, 3.75 inches)
In the same spirit as the generalization of Rubik's Cube $3 x 3 x 3$ to the Crazy Cube $3 x 3 \times 3$, this is a generalization of Jing's Pyraminx. Shown above is Meffert's "regular" version that has no restrictions on moves; each face can rotate around the circular portion in its center. Like the Crazy Cube $3 \times 3 \times 3$, Meffert's also has produced different move restriction variations, with names of the planets (Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune).
