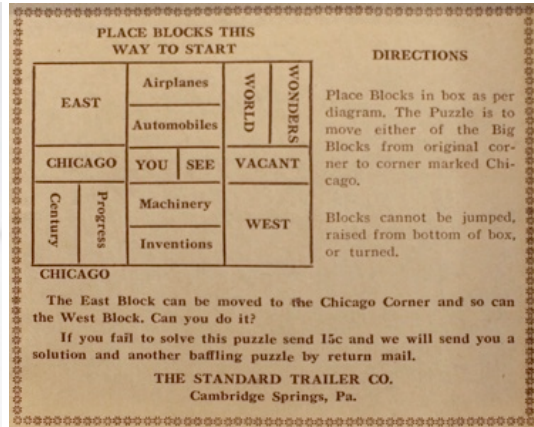

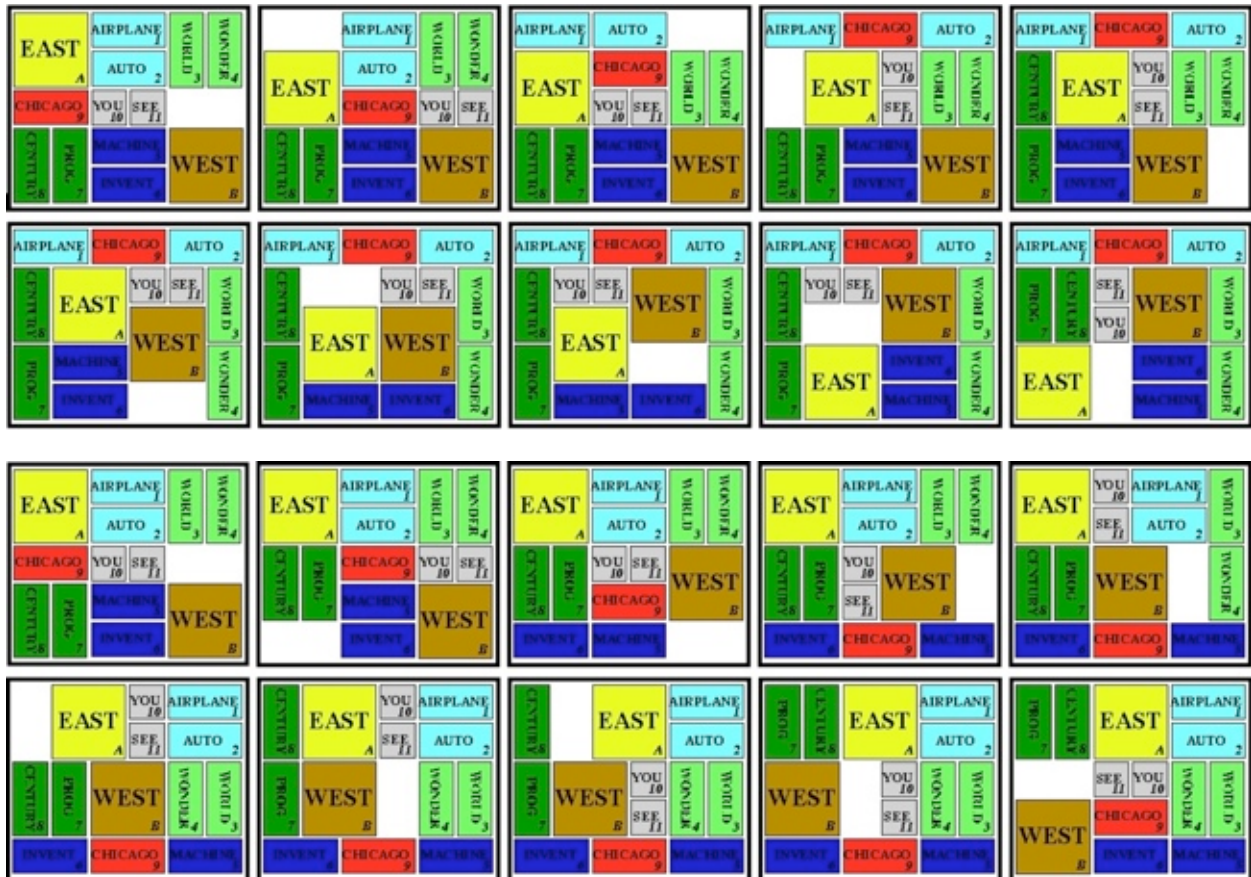


a.k.a. South Pole Expedition

(cardboard box and 13 wood pieces, 4" x 4.75" x 1/2"; directions inside the box top)

Hordern's book presents 37 moves (40 rectilinear moves) to slide EAST to the lower left and 42 moves (44 rectilinear moves) to slide WEST to the lower left; for both solutions, here are the starting position, each of the positions in after a 2x2 piece moves, and one other position:

SOUTH POLE
 CONTEST ENTRY BLANK IS UNDER THE BLOCKS

DIRECTIONS

PLACE BLOCKS IN BOX AS PER DIAGRAM. FIRST TRY TO MOVE THE AEROPLANE BLOCK TO CORNER MARKED SOUTH POLE. THEN REPLACE BLOCKS AS PER DIAGRAM AND TRY TO MOVE BLOCK MARKED DOG SLED TO CORNER MARKED SOUTH POLE.

BLOCKS CANNOT BE JUMPED, RAISED FROM BOTTOM OF THE BOX OR TURNED.

PUZZLE CAN BE SOLVED
