Below are the directions that came with the puzzle. Hordern's book dates this puzzle, and gives solutions of 27 moves to get the three discs to the center and 28 moves to get them to the bottom (with GOOD LUCK on the first two rows).

## RULES OF THE PUZZLE

Place the blocks in the box promiscously, then move into the position shown on the cover, the puzzle must be worked by moving the blocks past each other while lying flat in the boffom of the box.

After arranging the blocks as shown, then proceed to arrange them with the RED, WHITE and BLUE blocks in the center row, then finally in the lower row, each change is a puzzle within itself.
