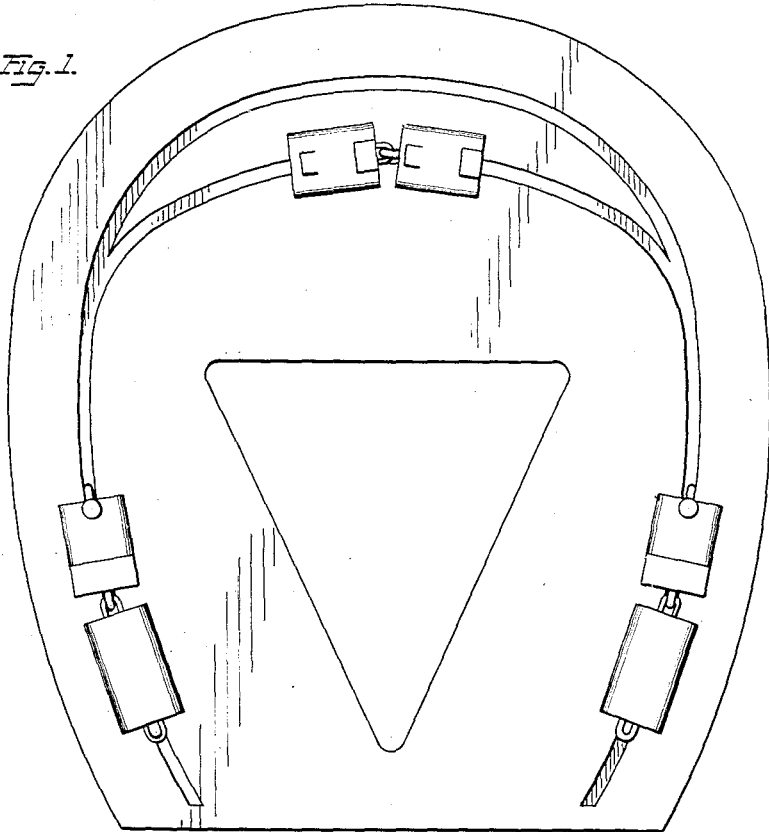

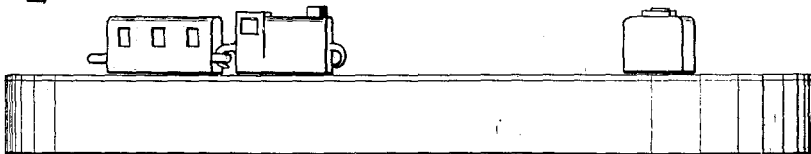
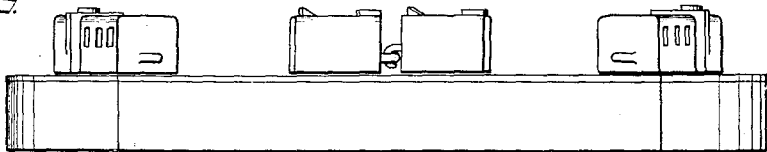

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William B. Sewell, a citizen of the United States, residing at Los Angeles, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Puzzle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a top view of a puzzle showing my new design;
