A smaller version of the *Fifteen Puzzle*. Although relatively easy, graphics on the pieces tend to make solving more difficult than if the pieces were the numbers 1 through 8.





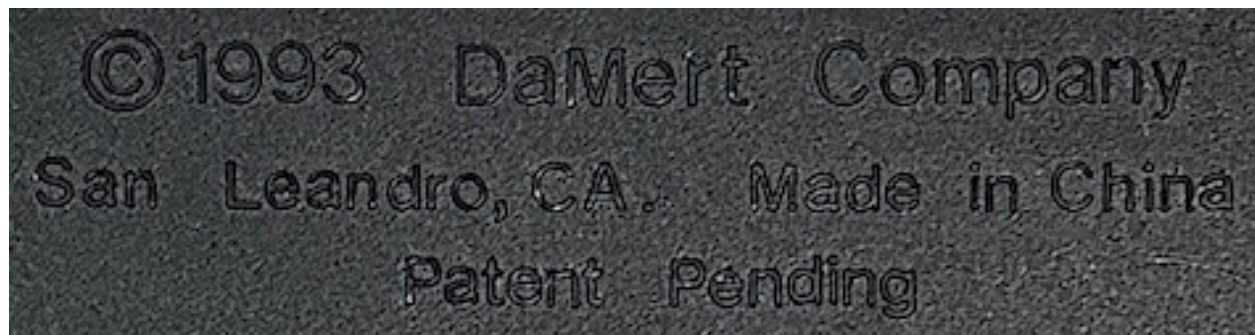

The copyright shown on the back of this puzzle (photo above) is 1993, 4 years earlier than the *Tweety* version, and shows the patent pending. DaMert made a number of these sliding puzzles all the same size, where some had copyrights in the intervening time, such as the *Turtle* puzzle (copyright DaMert 1994, San Leandro, CA) and the *Earth-Moon* puzzle (copyright DaMert 1996, Berkeley, CA).
