CD Organization

This CD is organized by track. Each directory contains the individual PDF documents in that track (e.g. "Machine Learning"). The tracks have been numbered according to their appearance in the contents. You can access papers by section by opening all the PDFs contained within a single directory (e.g. the directory named "10" contains all the papers in the Emotional Intelligence track. The contents file is called contents.pdf. The index file is called index.pdf.

Using the CD

To use all the features of this publication, you must have installed version 7 or above of Adobe Acrobat® or Adobe Acrobat Reader®. This software is NOT included in this CD. To obtain it, you must visit Adobe's website (www.adobe.com). Some versions of Adobe Acrobat Reader are available without charge.

IF YOU ARE NOT USING ADOBE ACROBAT 7 OR LATER OR ADOBE ACROBAT READER 7 or LATER, YOU MAY BE UNABLE TO USE THE FOLLOWING NAVIGATION FEATURES OF THIS CD.

Links

Destination links are provided from the contents file (contents.pdf) and the index file (index.pdf) of the proceedings included on this CD. To locate the contents page of the proceedings, select the hand tool (or another suitable navigation tool—check the Acrobat help files if you are unsure which tool to select) in Acrobat and position the curser over the word "Contents" or the word "Index" on the main navigation page and slowly move it until the pointer changes to a hand with a pointing finger. Then click the link to move to the new document. On some systems, the curser shape may be different. Consult the Acrobat help files if you are having trouble following a destination link.

The contents pages of the 2006 FLAIRS proceedings on this CD contain links to individual papers. For aesthetic purposes and to aid readability of the document, the links are hidden, but are easily located. To locate a particular paper, first navigate to the contents page of the proceedings, (the file name is contents.pdf) place your curser (be sure you have selected the proper tool in Acrobat) over the title of the paper on the contents page and slowly move it until the pointer changes to a hand with a pointing finger. Then click the link to move to the new document. To return to the contents page, choose "Document-->Goto Previous Document" in the Acrobat toolbar (on some systems and versions of Acrobat, the location and name of this command may differ). Consult the Acrobat help files if you are having trouble returning to the previous document. In some versions of Acrobat, a keyboard shortcut is available to return you to the previous document.

To follow a destination link in the index, position your curser over the page number associated with the document you want to read (be sure you have selected the proper tool in Acrobat). Position the pointer over the page number until the pointer changes to the hand with a pointing finger. Then click the link to move to the new document. To return to the index, choose "go to previous document" in the Acrobat toolbar.

Full Text Search

An index of this entire CD has been provided to enable full-text searches of all documents. To search the papers on this CD using the Adobe Acrobat Search command, you must first select the index to search. To add the index on this CD, follow the Acrobat Help instructions on adding indexes to search, and select the FLAIRS.pdx file provided on this CD.
