

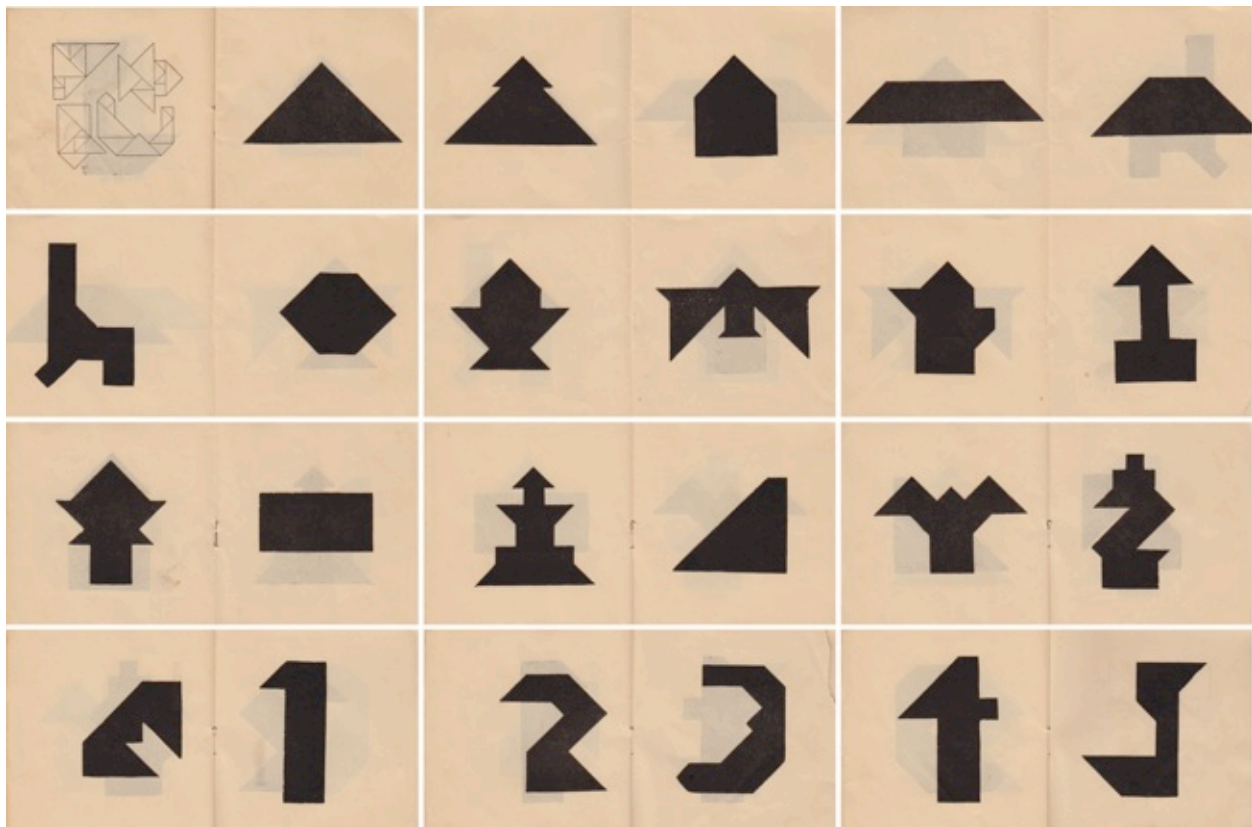
# King Tut's Puzzle



*Rockford Pattern Works, circa 1930's?*

(4.25" square by 5/8" thick box, 9 wood pieces, and 4" square booklet;  
some versions have the *Rinehimer Millwork* label on the box top)
