

New Fifteen Puzzle



The New "15" Puzzle.

INSTRUCTIONS.

Place the Discs on their proper numbers with the exception of No. 15, which is placed in the Centre. The puzzle is to get the 15 in its proper place, making one move at a time around the the edge, or to or from the Centre, ~~along the~~ lines marked with ~~grooves~~ to the position vacated by the last move. (NOTE.—In moving, the Discs must not be lifted out of the grooves).

To complete the puzzle all the Discs must be in their proper positions. **IT CAN BE DONE.**

ELEVEN more distinct and separate puzzles can be worked with this design and numbers, and these are as follows :—**Place** the 15 numbers around the edge so that each side of four figures totals 27, again to 28 or to 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36 or 37, thus forming one of the most unique and interesting puzzles ever discovered.
